Everyone,

I continue to harp on the condition of the lanais. Please remember that you have one chance to make a good first impression. You or someone else may be selling their unit and if your lanai is a mess, it reflects on the value of the whole community.

Did you know that this is a "No Pets" community? I'm sure you would have a hard time believing it when you see people walking dogs all over the place. There is a dog walking area in the northeastern corner of the property for this purpose. The only reason for having such an animal is if they are a registered Service Animal or a registered Emotional Support Animal. All other pets are forbidden to be at Village Brooke. I have personally observed several cats on lanais and have reported same to the office. I recommend you get rid of these pets asap.

There is a clause in our documents about riding around the complex on scooters, roller blades, electric mopeds and electric motorcycles. These are forbidden according to our documents. 
