Hello Everyone,

Slowly but surely, we are completing the various repairs from Hurricane Milton. It is frustrating yet understandable that things move more slowly than we would like. Most notably, the roof edge repairs on Building 5 and the fence at the south tennis court are still awaiting repairs.

I have mentioned recently that some of the lanais need attention and in a couple cases, some action has taken place and a screen or two has been repaired. More needs to be done to keep things looking nice and neat. Please remove unsightly items like piles of stuff, hanging towels, ratty-looking window treatments, etc. Look at your lanai from the outside and see if you think it looks good. Then do something about it if it does not.

The board and management are working hard together and will be issuing violations and levying fines to owners who do not respond when they are asked to correct a problem.

Since Milton, we have planted 14 trees. More trees will be planted going forward, as the budget allows.

There have been several incidents recently where residents and/or guests have been unruly at the pools, have brought food into the pool deck areas, and have even brought glass bottles onto the deck as well. There have been poorly supervised children running, jumping into the pools, and throwing things around. When asked to show a pool pass the people involved became confrontational. Every owner has the right and even the responsibility to ask anyone to produce their pass at the pool. The pass is supposed to be with you at the pool when you are there. We continue to investigate raising the fences at the pools and installing some form of fob or keyed entry to the pools.

Our staff is small and there is a lot of work to running Village Brooke. If you can avoid coming into the office when you have a problem, complaint, or maintenance issue, please do so. It is better to have a paper trail and you will if you send it by email to villagebrooke1@gmail.com.
